ETIQUETTE CLASS / DATES COMING SOON

MLCC will be hosting an Etiquette Class for all golfers 14 and younger. The Course will be required for all those golfers 14 and younger to be permitted on the course without an adult. Course safety, on course behavior and general golf rules will be addressed. Kids and parents can sign up for one of two classes being offered this spring. MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

We have 7 new full members and 9 trial members! Facebook and *Weekly Post* have been very helpful, but the best way to recruit new members is "WORD of MOUTH!" Please let your friends know about the Membership Promotions detailed below:

Membership Promotions until June 1, 2021

Full Membership – (Age 30 and over) \$900 to become a full voting member. This includes \$400 that goes towards the initiation fee and \$500 pays for your 3rd and 4th quarter dues. So for \$900 you can be paid up for 2021 and start paying dues in 2022! Normal Full membership is \$500 initiation fee and \$250 per quarter.

Starter Membership – (Age 29 and under) \$700 to become a full voting member. This includes \$400 that goes towards the initiation fee and \$300 pays for your 3rd and 4th quarter dues. So for \$700 you can be paid up for 2021 and start paying dues in 2022! Normal Starter membership is \$500 initiation fee and \$150 per quarter. Once the oldest adult in the starter membership turns 30, the member converts into a full membership and will start paying full membership dues.

Trial Membership – (one time option) \$500 receives a trial non-voting membership from Apr 1 to Sep 30.

NEW IN 2021

Non-Resident Membership – For \$500, any resident who lives more than 35 miles from the clubhouse and gets a non-voting membership good through Dec 31, 2021.

ADMINISTRATION NOTES

CARTS ON COURSE

As we are getting ready for golf season to be in full swing, please remember to purchase your 2021 sticker and display on your cart. Angie has the stickers in the Pro Shop and the fee for this year is \$100. Those proceeds, along with cart storage fees of \$100, go directly to the golf improvement fund and are critical for the long-term investment for the course. As a reminder, the only carts allowed on the

property are those owned and registered by Membership or Club Carts available for rental use. All drivers must be 16 and have a valid driver's license.

ACCESS FROM HURFF DRIVE

With the temperatures warming up, activity around the Club is increasing and more members are entering the property through the cart entrance from Hurff Drive. Please "slow down" and use caution when driving onto the grounds as there are some blind spots to be wary of, and especially as the pool starts to get busy, watch for swimmers walking to and from the Club.

BRING A GUEST

Among the many great things about Maple Lane is its affordability. One of the best ways to grow our Club is by introducing the property to potential members. If you do bring a guest to spend a day at the pool or play a round of golf, please remember to sign them in. If no one is available at the time of your visit, just let Angie know how their experience went when you connect with her to pay for their guest fees. Or if you would rather just do it before you forget, you can use PayPal. Angie can set you up if you need help.

LAKE

Just a reminder, the lake is for "fishing". Only golf carts rented from the Club or registered to Members are permitted in the area. Those under the age of 12 are not permitted on the property without a Member over the age of 18.
